



2024 Procedures

Claim rules:

Shock Carburetor Claim- in order to claim shocks or carburetor money must be given to an Ohio Wheelman Series Official BEFORE the drop of the green flag on the featured event. If the claimed part is not given up after the event, the driver will be DQ'd for the night.

Shock Claim- is \$500 per shock and must be purchased in pairs and claimed before the featured event or you can impound someone's shocks for \$210 each. Must be impounded in pairs. If impounded shock is deemed legal, shock will be returned to the race team. If shock is deemed illegal, it will be confiscated by the series.

Carburetor Claim- will be \$850 and must be done before the drop of the green flag before the featured event. This price may vary due to rising costs. If the car being claimed does not go to tech, they will be DQ'd for the night.

Scaling:

This year we will pass out numbers when you register. Those numbers will correlate to times you must be up for pre-tech. If you miss your time window, you will be forced to start scratch.

Restarts:

Leader gets a choice of lane on all restarts. Leader sets the pace. Front row will be warned 2 times before being sent tail.

Cautions:

We will be running 2 cautions in a heat race. You will be black flagged. 3 cautions in a feature you will be black flagged. No exceptions.

Protest:

You will have 15 minutes after a race to protest your final position with the race director. During a race if you want to protest your position, pull next to the car you are protesting. We will note it, double check, and reset positions if need be. You will be given 2 laps to take your position.

Disorderly Conduct/Unsportsman-like conduct:

Drivers are responsible for all of their crew members. Any physical altercations from any crew members in your crew will result in a \$500 fine and a 1 week suspension on your first offense. 2nd offense is \$1,000 fine and suspension for the season.

Speeding or reckless driving in the pits or during the race will result in \$200 for your first offense. 2nd offense is a \$500 fine and 1 week suspension. 3rd offense is \$1,000 and suspension for the rest of the season.

Rough Driving: 1st warning will come from the flag stand with a rolled up black flag. 2nd offense we will throw the black flag.

Retaliation: Retaliation during an event will be an automatic black flag, DQ for the night and a minimum \$200 fine for your first offense. 2nd offense is a \$500 fine and a 1 week suspension. 3rd offense is \$1,000 fine and suspension for the season. Officials will make decisions based on severity.

Tires:

All event tires must be scanned with a Wheelman Official prior to qualifying. You will be allowed 6 tires on opening day only and 4 per event after.

Tech Officials have the right to inspect any car at any time. Refusal will result in an automatic DQ for the night. You must show the tech area/part in question before coming back to compete again. Series also reserves the right to impound and confiscate any parts at any time.

We hold our drivers, teams, and staff to a much higher standard as we travel from state to state representing not only the series but our crew and our families. Remember this is about having fun and making memories.

Procedures can be amended throughout the season. Changes will be communicated on weekly lives, Facebook page, and website.
